# Animal Habitats

## KS2 School Session: Science

Use part of an animal's skeleton to work out what it was and where it lived, then recreate a habitat in LEGO®

### Learning Objectives:

- To be able to identify and describe animal features
- To understand that different animals need different habitats
- To understand how animals are suited to their environments
- UKS2 – understand how animals are adapted to their habitats & name adaptations

### Links to National Curriculum

- recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways
- identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment
- identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.
- To gain confidence in participating in discussions and presentations

### Animal Habitats:

Working in groups, use replica animal skulls to describe animal features, and classify animals. Work out in which habitat and where in the world their creatures live, and recreate a habitat using LEGO®

Years 5 & 6: work out how the animals were adapted to their environments from their features.
