As a helping hands volunteer you will be assisting our maintenance team who are always busy replacing light-bulbs, deep cleaning, oiling locks, repairing interactives and painting galleries.

This is an important part of Museum ensuring that our visitors have a wonderful experience, but also a vital part of protecting the collections for future generations.

We rely on our maintenance team to build and create displays, and to maintain, restore and repair our collection. Whether you are a skilled craftsperson, or are an enthusiastic DIY beginner, we have a project that need your help.

As a helping hands volunteer you will get to see areas of the Museum that are usually off limits to members of the public and see behind the scenes of upcoming exhibitions, as you assist with their installation.

Peterborough Museum & Art Gallery is one of the city's most historic buildings, tucked just behind the city centre on Priestgate Street.

Situated within a Georgian Mansion, this building has served as the cities Museum for over 70 years; featuring seven permanent galleries which display national and internationally important collections, alongside four evolving gallery spaces that offer a dynamic programme of events and exhibitions throughout the year.

Roles and Responsibilities:

Under the direction of the Museum Services Officer, you will assist with a variety of tasks such as...

- General repair and maintenance of the museum and gallery spaces.
- Monthly, weekly and daily safety checks ensuring compliance is up to date.
- Deep cleaning of gallery spaces on a rotational basis.
- Refreshing, painting and decorating museum and gallery spaces.

- Create and maintain museum displays, including emergency repairs.
- Exhibition installations, working alongside the collections & exhibitions team.
- Liaise with contractors as they carry out vital work for the Museum.

Training & Induction:

As a helping hands volunteer you will receive training on manual handling, working at heights, health & safety, fire awareness, as well as hands on training with members of the Museum team on how we create and maintain the museum and gallery spaces.

All necessary equipment and general PPE will be provided by the Museum. Please wear appropriate clothing for the current weather. This is an active role where clothing will get dirty or torn. Suitable strong footwear with a good grip is essential for this role.
