#### Learning Objectives:

- To develop historical skills with enquiry and evidence based learning.
- To develop greater understanding, knowledge and appreciation of their local history.
- To understand how local history fits in with national and international themes
- To develop an understanding of how our understanding of the past is constructed from a range of sources.
- To articulate and justify answers, arguments and opinions during group work and analysing the mystery objects.
- To gain confidence in participating in discussions and presentations

#### Activity

Unlabelled mystery objects have been delivered to the museum. We need help identifying what they are, what they tell us about Peterborough and how it has use them to tell the story of Peterborough.

A power point supports the story and objects and so access to a laptop and whiteboard are required.
