Travel back to 1574, and receive a Tudor ailment! Will you also get a cure? This was a period of great change for Peterborough and unfortunately also the time of some very nasty diseases and even nastier cures.

Learning Objectives:

- To study an aspect or theme in British history that extends pupils' chronological knowledge beyond 1066.
- To show an understanding of aspects of Tudor life and be able to note change, cause, similarity and difference, and significance
- To understand how past knowledge of medicinal herbs has been useful in developing modern drugs.
- To understand how our knowledge of the past is constructed from a range of sources.
- To participate in discussions, role-play, improvisations and debates

It's 1574 and the Tudor barber surgeon understands some children are feeling poorly... Discover some of the bizarre ideas and cures for Tudor ailments and what this tells us about life for rich and poor in Tudor Peterborough. (KS1-3)
