WWII: 10th May 1941

KS2+ School Session: History, English

Step back in time 1941 as Peterborough faces bombing raids, just like London in the Blitz. See how the ARP Warden would help you through an air raid.

Learning Objectives:

- To identify, understand and appreciate the impact that WW2 had on this area and on people's lives
- Understand the roles of volunteers like the ARP Warden and Home Guard

Activity

Meet the ARP Warden and learn about their role, and the role of other volunteers like the Home Guard.

Hear how Peterborough was affected by WW2

Handle real WWII artefacts and test out your gas masks, to learn what you would have to do in an air raid.

See how the volunteers would deal with an unexploded bomb!
